Dear valued member,

Even with a smaller membership than many other North Dakota organizations, NWLA is making a huge impact. We need your help to fight for our rights, and to stop the unprecedented taking of private property as a result of the Pore Space Bill, SB 2344. This Bill was signed by Governor Burgum on April 19 and now the looming question is, "How can we stop this?" The Board has been working diligently on this and has entered uncharted territory for this organization; but has decided to move ahead with a lawsuit against the State of North Dakota. We have not been able to share this with our members because of the sensitive nature of working with attorneys on litigation, but we are sending this out to members just prior to a public announcement so you are the first to know. This law is a bald-face taking of property rights and will have many unintended consequences if not stopped. Now is when we call upon the landowners of North Dakota to step up and protect your rights. We need you to make your voice heard!

There are several ways you can get involved. We need help spreading the word, and if you have neighbors or friends who have been thinking of joining the organization, now is the time. The other important help we need right now is resources, and a donation to Northwest Landowners Association in any amount will be used towards a campaign to raise public awareness on the importance of our private property rights, and this unprecedented taking of our rights and property. We also need your help with the legal costs to fight against SB 2344. Our attorneys already have many hours into this fight, and we are taking on a major battle for the landowners of North Dakota. We will also be reaching out to our members in the days to come to ask specific questions related to the lawsuit we have filed. This lawsuit is brought on behalf of our membership, so we will need to learn a little more about how SB 2344 affects our members as we move forward with litigation.
